

Notice of Election on Bond Issue and Tax Levy

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Resolution Nos. 10-94 and 10-96 of the Board of Education of the Norton City School District adopted on May 14, 2010 and May 17, 2010 there will be submitted to the electors of said school district at the Special Election to be held at the regular places of voting therein, on Tuesday, August 3, 2010, the following questions as a single proposal:

1. The question of the issuance of bonds for the purpose of constructing, furnishing, equipping, adding to, renovating, remodeling, rehabilitating, and improving school district buildings and facilities, and acquiring, clearing, improving and equipping real estate for school purposes, in the principal amount of \$27,505,239, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 37 years, and levy a property tax outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county fiscal officer to average over the bond repayment period 4.6 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 46 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds.
2. The question of levying an additional tax to provide funds for the acquisition, construction, enlargement, renovation, and financing of permanent improvements at a rate not exceeding 2 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 20 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, for a continuing period of time?

The taxes for said debt charges and permanent improvements will commence in 2010 and be first due in 2011. Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of Resolution Nos. 2010-33 and 2010-42 of the Board of Education of the Copley-Fairlawn City School District, adopted on April 27, 2010 and May 17, 2010, there will be submitted to the electors of said school district at the Special Election to be held in said school district at the regular places of voting therein, on August, 3, 2010, the question of an additional tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of said school district for the purpose of current expenses at a rate not exceeding 6.9 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 69 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
